

The trap can be set up as follows:

- 1) The cable is attached at both ends; the trap is not set and can therefore be used as a passage for luring the animal into the trap.
- 2) To set the trap, the cable is attached at both ends. Now the inner catch is placed onto the tip of the threaded rod and the two cables are detached. The inside flaps rest on the catch.
- 3) The flap is closed, and the trap has been sprung. By simply opening the outer flap and pulling the cable at the same time, the respective flap will be re-opened on that side.

Inside the trap, there is a rocker board where you can place various types of bait. Using the bait dome to lure animals (with the bait plate) has also proven effective in practice.

The trap can be triggered in three different ways: by tripping the bait, by stepping on the board or through contact with the setting mechanism. The setting mechanism is on the inside and therefore well protected. This makes the Weka invasiv live trap easy to shield from the outside. It is also weather resistant without any additional cover.
